Raydiant's X1 RAD (300 MBPS)

- Our X1 RAD combined a 200 Mbps leased line for the second office with two 4G routers from different providers, relying on three suppliers for one connection.
- With the RAD, the technology allows for simultaneous use of all services, meaning faster broadband from three different providers. SharePoint, OneDrive, and other cloud applications are no longer slowed down by poor speeds in the office, enabling them to scale for both the present and future of their business.
